
PRETORIA'S 'BIG' CYCLING BASH!

- Groot FM is proud to announce host the 3rd edition of DIE GROOT TRAP on 7 April 2024.
- The venue for the event is the impressive Sun Time Square Complex and the route offers distances over 105km, 65km and 17km. For 2-5 year-olds there is also a Spur kiddies ride!
- The venue is nicely accessible for riders from both Joburg and Pretoria. It presents ample parking as well as post-race entertainment and dining options which all add up to delightful day out for cyclists and their families.


ROUTE FLIPS ANTI-CLOCKWISE FOR 2024!

- All the 2024 Groot Trap routes leave Sun Arena Time Square in a Northerly direction via January Masilela to link up with a right turn onto Lynwood Road. The route runs East on Lynwood and crosses Solomon Mahlangu to go out towards Bronkhorstspruit on the M6.
- The 105km route turns left on the R25 and left onto the R568 to Bronkhorstspruit.
- The route turns left to come back on the old Bronkhorstspruit Road, left again into Solomon Mahlangu and then right at Atterbury.
- Out of Atterbury the event does a left into January Masilela and a final right turn into the home straight to finish in front of SunBet Arena.
- The 65km distance runs on the same routing as the 105km but turns short onto the Boschkop Road while the 17km turns right out of Lynwood Road onto Solomon Mahlangu to follow the same routing back to the finish line as the 65km and 105km.
- The total ascent on the 105km route is 995m while the 65km boasts 640m vertical ascent. The 17km run ride presents 210m of climbing.


105KM ROUTE | 995M ELEVATION
